Children's and Youth Work at Guiseley Baptist Church

Sunday Mornings:

Every Sunday Morning there will be sessions for children and youth run alongside our Sunday Morning worship. The children's session is for children up to year 6 and our youth Sessions are for young people from year 7 up to 17yrs of age.

Sunday evening:

Youth alpha - Every Sunday evening from 5:30- 7pm. This session allows young people to discuss different topics of faith. Food is also provided.

Midweek Activities

- **Table tennis club** ~ Every Monday from 4pm - 5:30pm open to children year 5 up to 17yrs. This group only runs during term time.
- **GCT kids club** ~ Every Monday from 6-7:15pm children aged 5 - 11yrs are welcome to Guiseley Methodist Church. This group only runs during term time.
- **Mainly Music** ~ Every Friday from 10-11am For Pre-school aged children. £3 Entry fee per family. Refreshments for both adults and children are available.
- **GBC Youth** ~ Every Friday from 7 - 8:30pm for young people year 7 to 17yrs. Various different games and activities including pool, table tennis and Xbox.
