VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR VINTAGE BLACON COMMUNITY GARDEN

Vintage Blacon has secured Big Lottery funding to build a Community Garden.

The URC on Saughall Road has generously allowed Vintage Blacon to use the area at the rear of the Church. The Conservation Volunteers will construct raised beds and hard standing footpaths around each bed over the summer to allow access for people with limited mobility. Plans include planting an orchard with heritage variety trees and the creation of a picnic area. All this will provide an educational and recreational resource for local groups and individuals.
