Teams include: welcome and hospitality, production and worship.

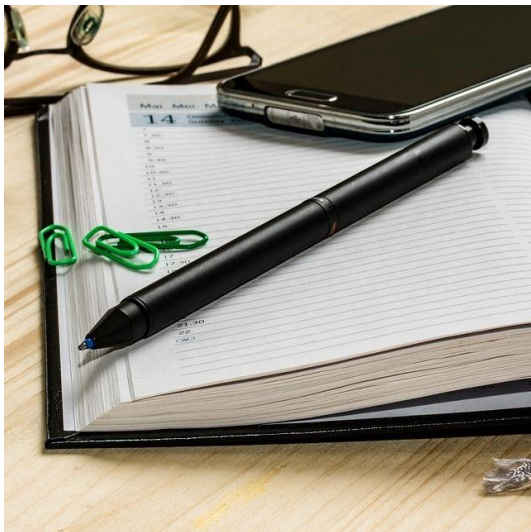




Foodbank for Students
