STEWARDS – A FINAL UPDATE

This is our final update as the stewarding team are changing their role. The stewards feel that we are at a stage where our role to help keep our mass attendees COVID secure, can now be changed to fall in line with the updated guidelines issued by both the Government and our Diocese. As the number of cases continues to be high we still feel it is important for us all to continue to act responsibly even if all Government restrictions have been lifted. To that end we will, for the time being:

1. Hope you will wear a face mask.
2. Provide hand sanitiser as you enter and leave church.
3. Offer the option of socially distanced seating as well as un-restricted seating.
4. Usher parishioners at communion, one bench at a time.
5. Ask you to leave church promptly as soon as mass has finished, conversations should take place outside.
