Collect

Gospel Reading: Matthew 11:16-19; 25-end

“But to what will I compare this generation? It is like children sitting in the marketplaces and calling to one another, ‘We played the flute for you, and you did not dance; we wailed, and you did not mourn.’

For John came neither eating nor drinking, and they say, 'He has a demon'; the Son of Man came eating and drinking, and they say, 'Look, a glutton and a drunkard, a friend of tax collectors and sinners!' Yet wisdom is vindicated by her deeds."

At that time Jesus said, "I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and the intelligent and have revealed them to infants; yes, Father, for such was your gracious will. All things have been handed over to me by my Father; and no one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal him.

"Come to me, all you that are weary and are carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me; for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light."

Reflection

In our reflection today there will be some words and then a time of silence to think about what has been said.

It's a funny old world, isn't it? When people can't join in with dancing. When they can't mourn together. When they complain because people have gathered together to eat. What are we to make of it? Are we weary of the place we find ourselves?

Pause

I think maybe we are all weary and burdened. Burdened by the toll of lockdown – not able to see or hug people we love, not being able to go out and about as we would normally. Burdened by the sadness of so many deaths, both here and across the world, for which families cannot grieve as they usually would. Burdened as we see people becoming poorer as others gain. Burdened by worry over the future as businesses fold and people are made redundant. Burdened as we watch world leaders making selfish choices and we feel powerless.

Pause

Jesus promises us refreshment and ease from those heavy burdens. We may rest in him.

And yet we are burdened by more than just these external things. We are burdened by the way we treat the natural world that we are just a part of; burdened by the way we sometimes see ourselves; burdened by the way that we sometimes see other people; burdened by the things that we do.

Pause

We are burdened by our sinfulness and so we come in confession to God.

Confession

Holy risk-taker, wonderful God, You create us out of your deep,
exuberant love and in great hope.
More than that, you make us in your own image;
We are humbled and enlivened by your faith in us.
Praise to your Name beyond all names.



But as we struggle to discover and perfect your image in ourselves, we struggle too to be rid of burdens which get in the way:

burdens of guilt, fear, despair,
burdens of anger, resentment, prejudice

Jesus Christ, perfection of God's image; as both judge and friend, we acknowledge our burdens to you, hiding none because you already know them.

Silence

**Forgive us where we have wrongly burdened others.
Help us to forgive those who have wrongly burdened us.
Release us from all that harms us;
help us to turn again—and again—
from selfishness to selflessness,
so that we grow in wisdom and maturity
towards the day when we become
perfect bearers of God's image. Amen**

You are free.

It is right to give thanks and praise.

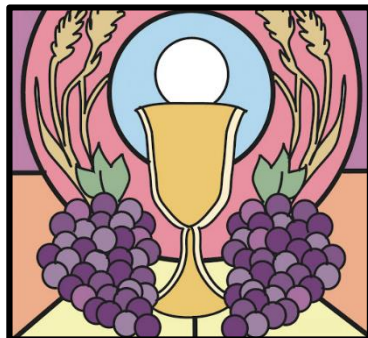
It is right to praise you, Father, Lord of all creation;
