### **Collect—A Special Prayer for Today**

Creator God, who made the world and blessed us with living creatures to be our friends: your care for us is unfailing. May our care for our pets be unfailing also, and in taking care of them, may we share in your love for all your creatures in Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

### **Readings**

*God formed out of the ground all the wild animals and all the birds of heaven. God brought them to the man to see what he could call them, and whatever the man called each living creature, that was its name. (Genesis 2:19)*

*I will remember my covenant which is between me and you and every living creature of all flesh. (Genesis 9:15)*

We have just heard that God will remember his covenant but what is a covenant? It is a kind of promise or agreement. God has promised to take care of us and all living creatures. Within that promise is the agreement that we will take care of the creatures that we live alongside. But because we so often fail to keep this agreement we need to say sorry for our faults:

## **Confession: We Say Sorry to God**

Holy God, you made a covenant with us;  
despite all our faults you have bound yourself to us;  
despite our violence you have promised a covenant of peace;  
despite our infidelity you have remained faithful to us.

Truly, you are a remarkable God whose graciousness knows no limits  
and before whom no creature is left desolate.

Not only have you created the great Earth but also you are to each and  
every creature their kind and loving God;  
everything living looks to you for their sustenance and care;  
without you, all the creatures of the earth would perish.

**All these living creatures you have put under our protection  
and we are to care for them as you care for us;  
but we know that we have often treated them  
selfishly and thoughtlessly;  
we have thought of them only as objects  
for our amusement and pleasure;  
we have neglected their true needs; we have betrayed your trust.**

*Pause for reflection*

**For these sins, gracious God we are truly sorry;  
we ask your pardon and forgiveness.**

### **Story: Benno and the Frogs**

Benno was a very holy man and several stories were told about him. He was so holy that he prayed nearly all day long. He would go into the woods and pray for hour after hour.

One day in late spring or early summer, he went out as usual. He saw that everything was very beautiful—the blossom on the trees; the swallows skimming through the blue sky; the warmth of the air... He knew that his main prayer today would be to thank God for all of these beautiful things. So, Benno raised his arms to heaven, opened his mouth and... **BAAAA!** It was the sheep in a nearby field. ‘Stop that!’ shouted Benno, ‘I can’t think with that row going on, let alone pray!’ So the sheep, who knew that they had to obey such a holy person, stopped bleating.

Benno raised his arms again and opened his mouth to pray... **MOO! MOO! MOO!** This time it was the cows in the pasture over there. And what was worse, the sheep started bleating as well. ‘Oh for goodness sake!’ said Benno. ‘I’m trying to pray!’ So the sheep and the cows stopped their noise.

Benno raised his arms for a third time. ‘O Lord...’ **TWEET! TWEET! TWEET!** ‘I can’t believe it’, Benno grumbled. He looked up. There was a blackbird’s nest in one of the trees. Some eggs had just hatched and the

fledglings were making a racket. And, this started the sheep and the cows as well. ‘Excuse me, you lot, someone’s trying to pray down here. Could you please, Mrs Blackbird, stop your babies from making such a din!’ So Mrs Blackbird, who knew she had to obey such a holy person, chopped up a worm and popped it into her young ones’ mouths and told them that they had to stay quiet. And the sheep and the cows stopped as well.

Benno raised his arms yet again and started to pray... **CROAK! CROAK! CROAK!** And when the frogs croaked, the birds started twittering and the cows started mooing and the sheep started bleating. ‘I can’t believe it! I just can’t believe it!’ shouted Benno. ‘You lot in that pond, pipe down! I’m trying to pray!’ **CROAK! CROAK! CROAK! TWEET! TWEET! TWEET! MOO! MOO! MOO! BAAAA!**

Benno still couldn’t pray. ‘It’s just not good enough! Turn it off completely!’ But it was no good. The animals were enjoying themselves so much that they just couldn’t stop. Benno was really cross by now. ‘That’s it, I have had enough! Right. I want every animal in this wood to listen to me. I am a very holy person and it’s my job to pray, but I can’t pray with all this racket going on, so you’re all going to have to shut up. Stop making such a din!’

As soon as he said this, the wood fell silent. Benno was really pleased. He raised his arms and opened his mouth to pray—but nothing happened. He tried to make his tongue make some sounds but words just wouldn’t come out. He put his fingers in his mouth and gave his tongue a twiddle, but it was no use. The words still wouldn’t happen.

Then suddenly God sent him a memory. He remembered a story from the Bible. It was the story of three Jewish men called Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego who had been captured by Nebuchadnezzar, the king of Babylon and ordered to bow down and worship a golden statue that he had made. They refused and said that they would only worship the true god, the God of Israel who made heaven and earth.

The king of Babylon got so angry that he ordered them to be thrown into a burning fiery furnace. But when they were thrown in an angel came to them and they were not burned or harmed in any way. While they were in the burning fiery furnace they sang a great song of thankfulness to God. Benno remembered some of the lines from their song:

Give thanks to the Lord you whales and all that swim in the waters:

**Give him thanks and praise him for ever.**

Give thanks to the Lord all birds of the air:

**Give him thanks and praise him for ever.**

Give thanks to the Lord all people on earth:  
**Give him thanks and praise him for ever.**

Benno suddenly realized that the bleating of the sheep and the mooing of the cows and the singing of the birds and the croaking of the frogs might be pleasing to God. In fact, it might be even more pleasing than his own prayers. So, he said sorry to all the animals and told them that they could make as much noise as they liked. From that moment his tongue was loosened and he could pray again.

*Pause*

If our pets could speak so we could understand them now... If we could hear them pray, I wonder what they would say. I came across this prayer, the Prayer of the Cat:

*Lord, I am the cat, It is not, exactly, that I have something to ask of you!  
No—I ask nothing of anyone—but, if you have by some chance, in some celestial barn, a little white mouse, or a saucer of milk,  
I know someone who would relish them.  
Wouldn't you like some day to put a curse on the whole race of dogs?  
If so I should say, **Amen.***

I wonder what a dog would pray for? A rug by the fire, a bone to gnaw and plenty of walks?

**I promise to be so faithful.**

You might like to touch/pat/stroke your pet as a sign of the covenant reaffirmed between you.

May the God of the new covenant of Jesus Christ grant you grace to fulfil your promise and to show mercy to other creatures as God has shown mercy to you. **Amen.**

*Pause*

Eternal Father,

**we thank you for these creatures who live alongside us as our companions and friends; for their loyalty, love and trust which enrich our lives and give us joy; teach us the value of kindness, the power of mercy, and the strength of gentleness.**

**We ask this through your Son, Jesus Christ, whose new covenant of love gives life to us all. Amen.**

*We draw all our prayers together in the words that Jesus taught us*

**Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name.**

**Your kingdom come, your will be done, on Earth as it is in heaven.**

**Give us today our daily bread.**

**Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us.**

**Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil.**

**For the kingdom, the power and the glory are yours, now and for ever. Amen.**
