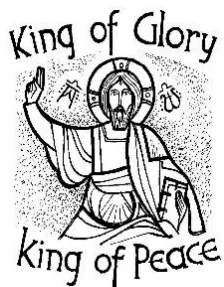


# Welcome to the Anglican Parish of St Augustine of Canterbury, Belvedere
