## Mark 10: 17-31

Here are some activities you can do this week together as a family



### BIBLE PASSAGE

Read together the story from Mark 10: 17-31 and then consider the questions below:

- I wonder which possessions you think are very important to you?
- I wonder which possession you would find the hardest to give away?
- I wonder if you have ever got an unexpected answer to a question?

A rich man asks Jesus what he must do to inherit eternal life. He then discovers the cost of it.

### Dress up relay race

Challenge someone to race against you!

- At one end of the room put two piles of items of clothes (about ten items each) it could be anything from scarves to t shirts to hats
- Race each other to put on the clothes over yours as quickly as possible!
- Then race back to the start

You could even play this game on your own by racing against the clock. Keep trying to beat your best time.



### Memory verse

### GET CREATIVE!

#### Memory verse paper windsock

You will need: strips of tissue paper or ribbon, paper, string, tape or glue

- On an A5 piece of paper write the memory verse (as above) and decorate
- Roll up to create a tube shape and tape together
- Tape/ glue strips of tissue paper or ribbon all around the inside edge of the tube at one end - use different colours
- Punch two hole in the top of the windsock directly across from each other
- Thread a piece of string through both holes, then tie the ends together
- Then you can hang your windsock up
