BIBLE PASSAGE

Read together the story from Luke 9: 51-62 and then consider the questions below:

- I wonder what things are important to you?
- I wonder what things might you follow eg a sports team?
- I wonder what challenges we might face today following Jesus?

In this week's passage Jesus teaches how it can be hard to be a disciple because many of us have different priorities. Being a disciple can change how we live.



Just for fun – YES and NO game
Before playing the game you will need a list of questions such as;

- Is it your birthday today?
- Did you say yes it is your birthday today?
- Is it correct you are 11 years old?
- Do you like chocolate?

You will need: card, scissors, pipe cleaners, pens, tape

- ❖ Cut out a flip flop shape from card and then make three holes (so it looks like a triangle) near the top of the flip flop.
- ❖ Thread two pipe cleaners through the holes (to create the straps of the flip flop that go between the big toe)
- ❖ You could thread beads and buttons through the pipe cleaner before securing them underneath the flip flop shape with tape
- ❖ Decorate your flip flop and write the words 'I am following Jesus'
