Luke 12: 13 -21

Here are some activities you can do this week together as a family



BIBLE PASSAGE

Read together the story from Luke 12: 13 - 21 and then consider the questions below:

- I wonder what do you think of when you think of treasure?
- I wonder what things people might have in abundance?
- I wonder what things might be difficult to share with others?
- I wonder what things we can share with others?
- I wonder what treasures God values?

Jesus is asked to resolve a family dispute and tells a parable to warn people not to be greedy.

Treasure hunt game

On pieces of coloured card write the words hope, love, caring, sharing, kindness
Hide the pieces of card around the room and invite others to try and find the hidden cards

Money races

You will need: a piece of card cut up into 12 rectangles (this will be the money) and a dice
On 6 of the pieces of card label them £1, £2, £3, £4, £5, £6 . And on the other 6 pieces of card label them the same so you have two sets for two team.
In teams roll the dice, so if you roll a 1 race and collect the £1 card. But you need to roll a 6 first to start the game. The winning team is the team who collects all the money first!
