

Daily Morning Prayer

Find a quiet place and allow enough time so as not to be rushed and not to cut short the time of listening. Sit for a few moments and take time to relax – take a couple of deep breaths – light a candle or turn on some quiet music or find a picture. We come from scattered lives to meet with God. Let us recognise God's presence with us now.

When you are ready please use this form of Morning Prayer.

Keep a short silence, still your heart.

As God's people we have gathered;
let us worship God now together,
across the miles yet joined.
Let us pray:

Come, Holy Spirit,
fill the hearts of your faithful people,
and kindle in us the fire of your love;
through Jesus Christ our Lord, Amen.

In the light of Jesus, let us examine ourselves and confess our sins.

Keep a short silence, leave your sins at foot of the cross .

Father, we have sinned against heaven and against you.
We are not worthy to be called your children.
We turn to you again,
have mercy on us,
bring us back to yourself as those who once were dead but now have life
through Christ our Lord. Amen.

May the Father forgive us by the death of the Son,
and strengthen us to live in the power of the Spirit all our days. Amen.

The psalm for the day from the list ending with

Glory to the Father and to the Son
and to the Holy Spirit;
as it was in the beginning is now
and shall be for ever. Amen.

The reading from the list (any version of the Bible is appropriate – 2 different ones to compare the translations would be good if you can) followed by a short time of meditation on the reading.

Ask yourself one of the following questions about the reading:

Does this reflect anything which is happening to me at this time?

Does this reflect what is happening in the world today?

Would I have reacted in the same way as those who were there at the time?

Did this passage strike me as interesting, profound, difficult to understand or enlightening?

We affirm our faith in Jesus Christ, the Son of God:

Though he was divine,
he did not cling to equality with God,
but made himself nothing.
Taking the form of a slave,
he was born in human likeness.
He humbled himself and was obedient to death,
even the death of the cross.
Therefore, God has raised him on high,
and given him the name above every name:
that at the name of Jesus
every knee should bow,
and every voice proclaim that Jesus Christ is Lord,
to the glory of God the Father. Amen.

in spiritual commitment to you,

We intercede for others in the quiet of our hearts.
Lord, meet us in the silence, and hear our prayer.

Your own prayers from items on the news, the prayers for the sick, the prayers for the deceased and any prayers you are moved to make.

glory in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ,
our salvation and hope,
who reigns as Lord now and forever.
Fill us, Good Lord with your Spirit of love;
and as you have fed us with your presence,
so, make us one in heart and mind,

2nd Sunday before Lent (07.02.21 – 13.02.21)

Almighty God,
you have created the heavens and the earth
and made us in your own image:
teach us to discern your hand in all your works
and your likeness in all your children;
through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord,
who with you and the Holy Spirit reigns supreme over all things,
now and for ever. Amen.

Sunday Next Before Lent (14.02.21 – 16.02.21)

Almighty Father,
whose Son was revealed in majesty
before he suffered death upon the cross:
give us grace to perceive his glory, that we may be strengthened to suffer with him
and be changed into his likeness, from glory to glory;
who is alive and reigns with you,
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
one God, now and for ever. Amen.

Lent Season

(Ash Wednesday 17.02.21 up to and including day before Palm Sunday 27.03.21)

Almighty God
by the prayer and discipline of Lent
may we enter into the mystery of Christ's sufferings,
and by following in his Way
come to share in his glory;
through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Ash Wednesday (17.02.21)

Almighty and everlasting God,
you hate nothing that you have made
and forgive the sins of those who are penitent:
create and make in us new and contrite hearts
that we, worthily lamenting our sins
and acknowledging our wretchedness,
may receive from you, the God of all mercy,
perfect remission and forgiveness;

we may know the power of your presence to bind together and to heal;
through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

St Patrick (17.03.21)

Almighty God,
who in your providence chose your servant Patrick
to be the apostle of the Irish people:
keep alive in us the fire of the faith he kindled
and strengthen us in our pilgrimage towards the light of everlasting life;
through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

St Joseph of Nazareth (19.03.21)

O God our Father,
who from the family of your servant David
raised up Joseph the Carpenter
to be the guardian of your incarnate Son
and husband of the Blessed Virgin Mary:
give us grace to follow him
in faithful obedience to your commands;
through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Passiontide begins/5th Sunday of Lent (21.03.21 – 27.03.21 except 25.03.21)

Almighty God,
you have created the heavens and the earth
and made us in your own image:
teach us to discern your hand in all your works
and your likeness in all your children;
through Jesus Christ, your Son, our Lord,
who with you and the Holy Spirit reigns supreme over all things,
now and for ever. Amen.

Annunciation of our Lord to the Blessed Virgin Mary (25.03.21)

We beseech you O Lord
pour your grace into our hearts;
that, as we have known the incarnation of your Son Jesus Christ by the message of an
angel,
so by his cross and passion
we may be brought unto the glory of his resurrection;
through Jesus Christ thy Son our Lord. Amen.

6th Sunday of Lent/Palm Sunday

Almighty and everlasting God,
who in your tender love towards the human race sent your Son our Saviour Jesus Christ
to take upon him our flesh
and to suffer death upon the cross:
grant that we may follow the example of his patience and humility,
and also be made partakers of his resurrection;
through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Maundy Thursday (01.04.21)

God our Father
you have invited us to share in the supper
which your Son gave to his church
to proclaim his death until he comes:
may he nourish us by his presence,
and unite us in his love;
who is alive and reigns with you,
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
one God, now and for ever. Amen.

Good Friday (02.04.21)

Almighty Father,
look with mercy on your family
for which our Lord Jesus Christ was content to be betrayed
and given up into the hands of sinners
and to suffer death upon the cross;
who is alive and glorified with you and the Holy Spirit,
one God, now and for ever. Amen.

Easter Eve (03.04.21)

Grant, Lord,
that we who are baptised into the death of your Son our Saviour Jesus Christ
may continually put to death our evil desires and be buried with him;
and that through the grace and the gate of death
we may pass to our joyful resurrection;
through his merits,
who died and was buried and rose again for us,
your Son Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Easter Day (04.04.21 – 10.04.21))

Lord of all life and power,
who through the mighty resurrection of your Son
overcame the old order of sin and death
to make all things new in him:
grant that we, being dead to sin
and alive to you in Jesus Christ,
may reign with him in glory;
to whom with you and the Holy Spirit
be praise and honour, glory and might,
now and in all eternity. Amen.

2nd of Easter (11.04.21 – 17.04.21)

Almighty Father,
you have given your only Son to die for our sins
and to rise again for our justification:
grant us so to put away the leaven of malice and wickedness
that we may always serve you
in pureness of living and truth;
through the merits of your Son Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

3rd of Easter (18.04.21 – 24.04.21 except 23.04.21)

Almighty Father,
who in your great mercy gladdened the disciples with the sight of the risen Lord:
give us such knowledge of his presence with us,
that we may be strengthened and sustained by his risen life
and serve you continually in righteousness and truth;
through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

St. George (23.04.21)

God of hosts,
who so kindled the flame of love
in the heart of your servant George
that he bore witness to the risen Lord
by his life and by his death:
give us the same faith and power of love
that we who rejoice in his triumphs
may come to share with him the fullness of the resurrection;
through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

4th of Easter (25.04.21 – 01.05.21 except 26.04.21)

Almighty God,
whose Son Jesus Christ is the resurrection and the life:
raise us who trust in him,
from the death of sin to the life of righteousness
that we may seek those things which are above,
where he reigns with you
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
one God, now and for ever. Amen.

Mark the Evangelist (25.04.21)

Almighty God,
who enlightened your holy Church
through the inspired witness of your evangelist Saint Mark:
grant that we, being firmly grounded in the truth of the gospel,
may be faithful to its teaching both in word and deed;
through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
