

Booking	<p>To ensure we do not exceed our maximum number of people a booking system has been introduced. Maximum number	28 We can't allow more than this to attend.
Covid symptoms	Summary of Covid19 symptoms will be displayed. No one should attend church if you are showing any recognised symptoms or if members of your family are showing recognised symptoms. (a new continuous cough, a high temperature or a loss of, or change, in your normal sense of taste or smell)
Social distancing	If you attend church, you will need to adhere to social distancing – There should be no physical contact with anyone outside of your household group
Hand sanitiser	You will be asked to use hand sanitiser before entering the church building
Face coverings	You will be asked to wear face coverings in line with Government requirements. Please note that visors do not meet the necessary criteria for face coverings and is not acceptable as an alternative to a mask
One-way system when entering hall  ** Church	<p>When entering the **, you will be directed by the steward where to sit. You must not sit where you want to or reposition chairs.  You must remain seated until instructed to leave, and again follow the instructions given by the steward, maintaining social distancing and continuing to wear a face covering  Children must always be accompanied by an adult</p>
