



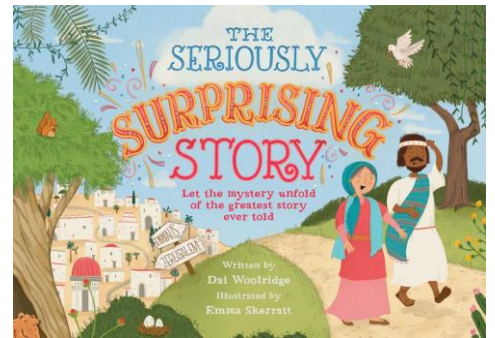

Why not try one of these craft ideas?

1. Draw a picture of a road or Path with some trees and grass onto a piece of card. Carefully use some scissors to make a horizontal cut approx 5 cm from the bottom of the picture. Make sure you **don't** cut right to the edges of the card though! Draw three people onto another piece of card. Cut them out and then attach them to a lollypop stick. Slide the lollypop stick through the hole on the backdrop. Have fun moving the people along the road. Can you remember who they are, and what they talked about?

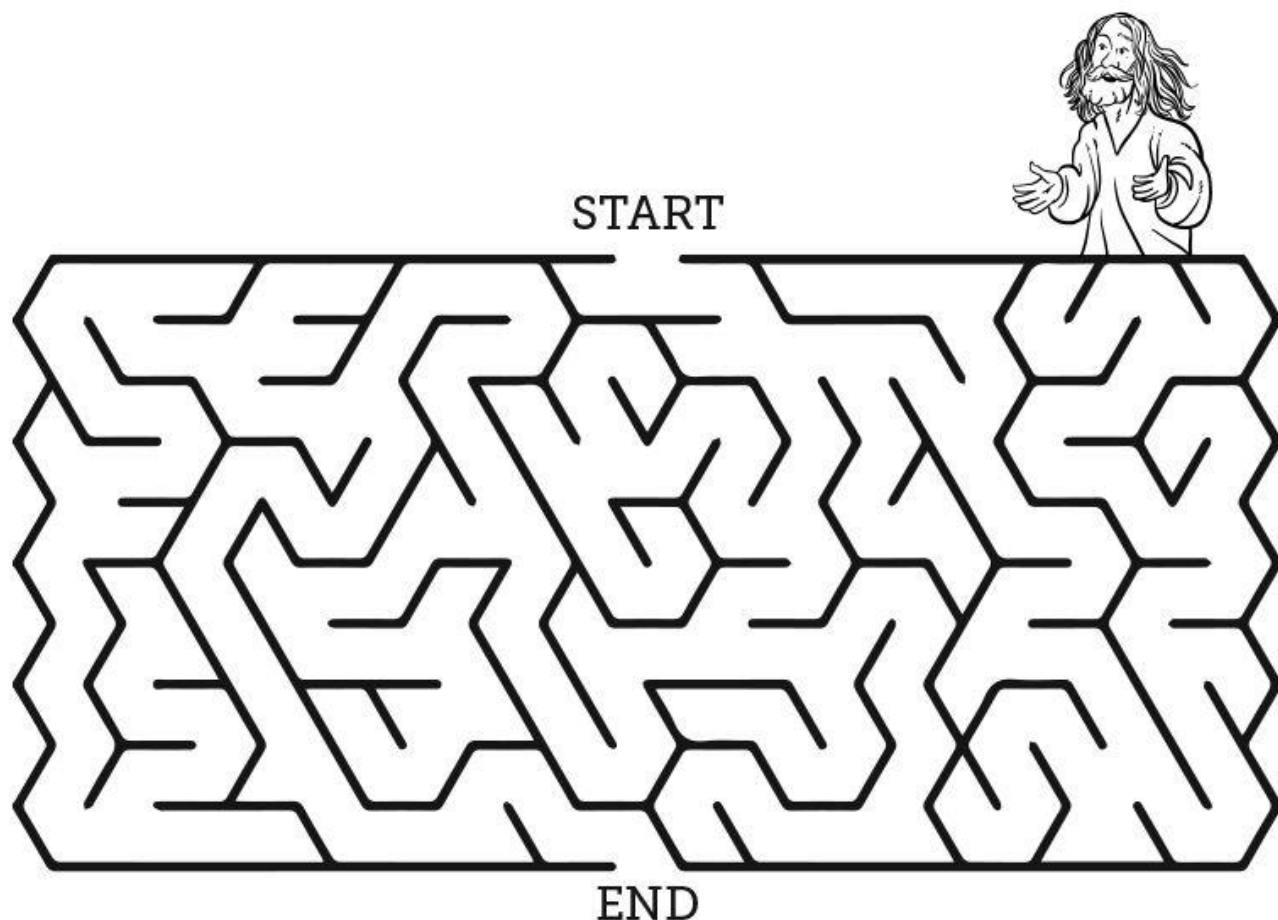

A prayer: Dear God, Thank you for sending Jesus to die for us on a cross so that we can be forgiven and one day live with you in heaven. Amen

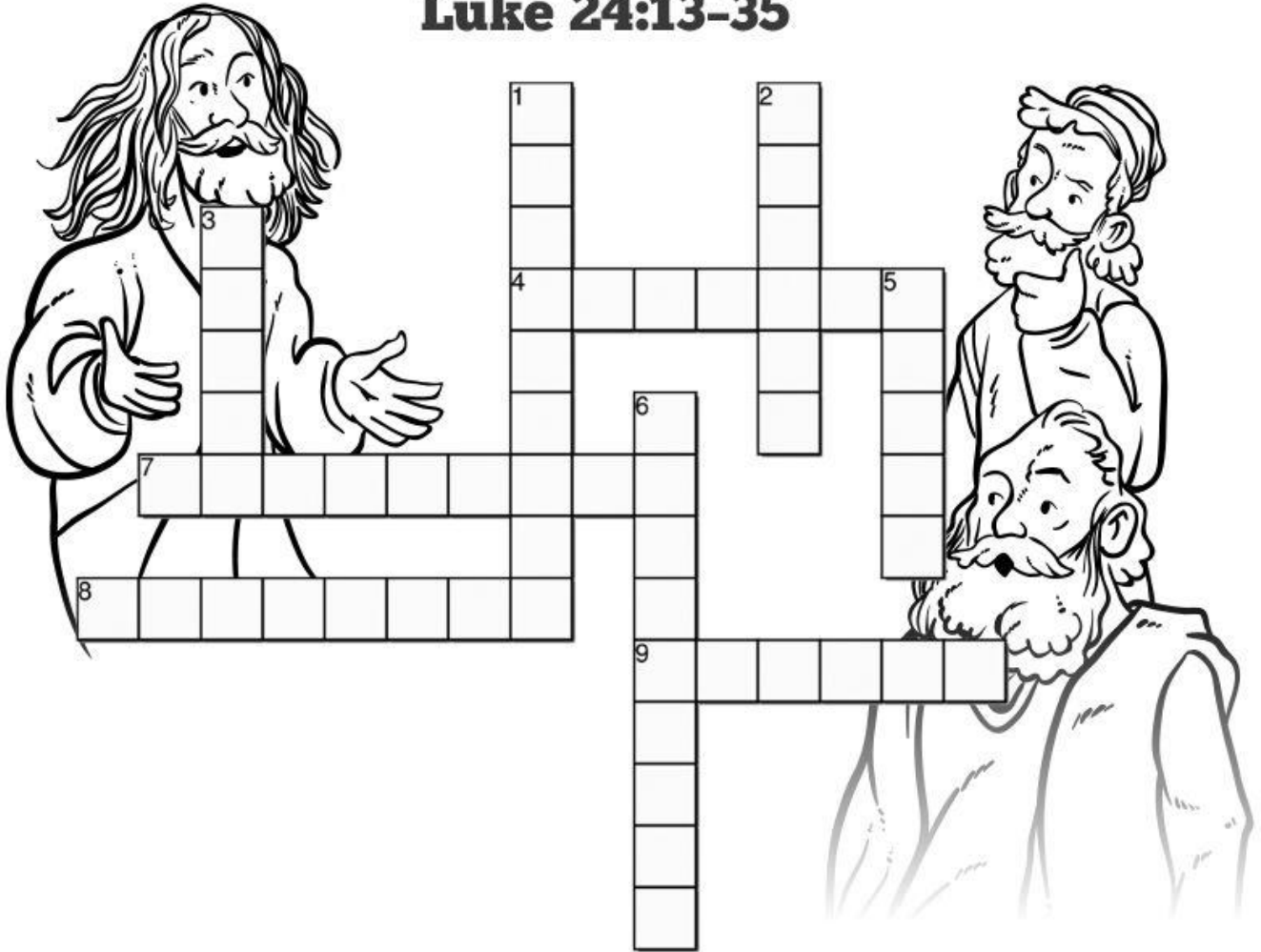

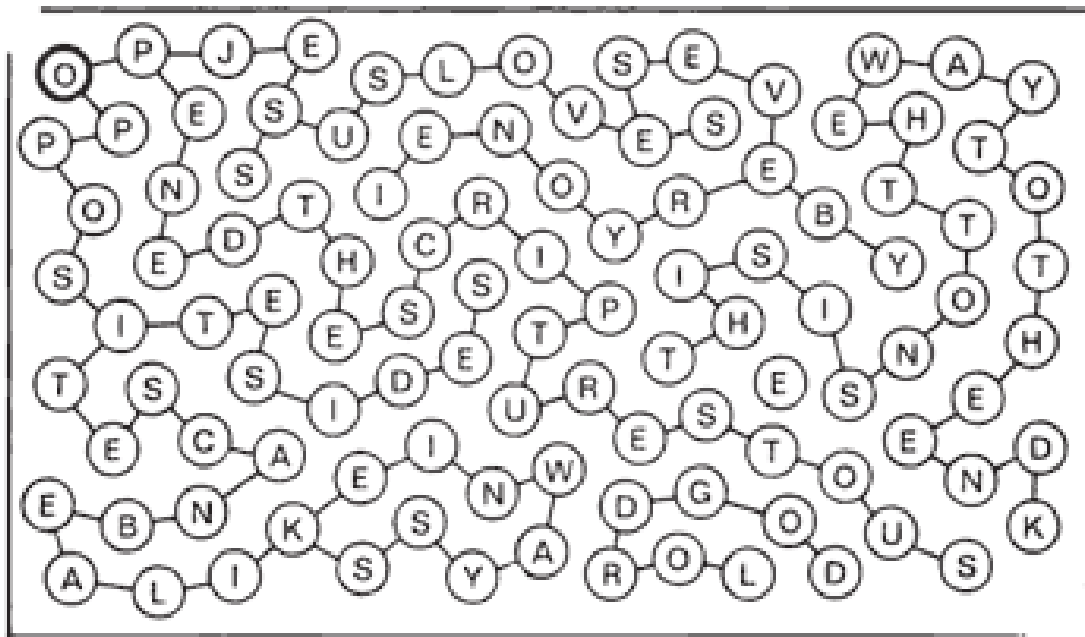
