Ann Golding was born in Bromley and attended Highfield School as a child when it was a single school. She went on to Hayes Secondary School before obtaining her B. Ed. at Brighton. She is married with two sons and 2 cats! Her interests include education, walking, gardening, travel and painting. Commenting on her appointment Ann said 'I am looking forward to starting in September. I have already been made to feel very welcome by children and staff. I know I can continue to build on the work

that David Payne and Jason Wood have done.'

Karen Bigg was born in Surrey and was educated in Sutton before moving to Warwick. As a member of the Warwickshire County Youth Orchestra she appeared on Blue Peter! Karen later studied at Middlesex University where she obtained a B.Ed.(Honours) with a music specialism - she plays the clarinet.

On finishing her training, Karen's first post was in Newham. She then taught at a junior school in Croydon, where she had particular responsibility for special needs



provision, before moving on to Redbridge Primary School with over 700 children. In January 2000 she became Deputy Head of Highfield Junior School, teaching year 3 classes and then maths groups across the school. Karen moved on in 2004 and became Head Teacher of a Medway junior school. In September 2007 she moved back to Highfield as Acting Head Teacher and has subsequently been appointed as Head.

Karen lists amongst her interests music, netball (she played for Shirley Netball Club for many years), travel and coastal walks. She lives in

Ramsgate (although she is considering moving closer to Shortlands now!) with her husband and 2 cats. Following her appointment Karen told us 'I am currently working to develop further our relationship with the Infants School. Jason Wood and I recently appointed a Joint Family Worker to strengthen the links between home and both schools and I am also keen to develop links with the community.'

Yet again, it was standing room only at the Shortlands Residents' Association (SRA) AGM on 23 April. The event is when Shortlands residents turn out in force, with Beckenham MP Jacqui Lait and Councillors George Taylor, Ernest Noad and Michael Tickner, to hear about progress in the last year.

In his report Chairman Mark Dempsey said; "One of our objectives for the year was to set up an SRA web site for residents, and I am delighted that this is now up and running. It already contains a lot of interesting information about the SRA, Shortlands itself and useful local

contacts. But we want it to be something for the whole community. So if local groups or residents have events or activities that they would like to promote we'd be very happy to hear from you". The website is at www.shortlandsresidents.org.uk.

The AGM also provided an opportunity to hear from Sergeant David Harvey and his colleagues about the work of the Safer Neighbourhood Team (SNT). He valiantly stepped in at short notice after the Borough Commander for Bromley could not attend. Residents commented on how helpful and effective they found the team to be,

but several also mentioned that there were problems with communications that meant it could be difficult to get hold of the team. Jacqui Lait MP is now taking this up with Sir Ian Blair and the Commander for Bromley.

Looking forward, next year marks the 75th anniversary of the SRA. Mark said, "We are working up a series of activities to commemorate the occasion, but if residents have ideas or can help with planning and organising things, we would be delighted to hear from them."
