PUBLIC NOTICE

In the Consistory Court of the Diocese of Salisbury

Church of: Calne St Mary
In the Parish of: Calne and Blackland

NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are making application to the Consistory Court of the Diocese for permission to carry out the following

- a) Re-hang the eight existing bells and install two new treble bells, the bells to be tuned and turned before re-hanging with any existing canons and crown staples also to be removed
- b) Installation of a lifting beam in the current belfry to enable the bells to be moved
- c) Installation of internal and adjustable external sound control together with the creation of a new sound deadening chamber above the ringing chamber
- d) Re-siting of the clock in a new room above the bells and its conversion to electric winding; removal of the clock weight chute from the ringing chamber
- e) Restore and re-gild the clock face and hands on the west side of the tower
- f) Installation of new lighting and power points in the tower stairway and in upper levels
- g) Installation of fixed heating to replace existing portable heaters
- h) Reinstatement of an opening window in the ringing chamber and repair of broken glazing in other windows
- i) Move and safely store the Gillett & Johnson metal carillon drum chiming mechanism of 1886

A letter of objection must include your name and address and state whether you live in the parish and/or your name is entered on the church electoral roll of the parish or any other basis on which you have an interest in the matter. You may not object anonymously.

DIRECTIONS TO PETITIONERS

You must display this Public Notice (or a copy of it) for a continuous period of not less than 28 days, not counting the day on which it is put up or the day on which it is taken down, (or for such other period as the Court may direct) in each of the following places:

1. On a notice board or in some other prominent position inside the church.
2. On a notice board outside the church or in some other prominent position (whether on the outside of the church door or elsewhere) so that it is readily visible to the public.
