Queens Road Church Centre**

Queen's Road Baptist Church Centre

Located just off junction 6 of the ring road the church centre is a few minutes away from the heart of Coventry city centre. We are only a short walk from the rail station and easily accessible from the motorway network.

The church centre has free on site parking and a large pay and display site close by.

Queen's Road Baptist Church Centre offers a quality venue suitable for meetings, conferences, training seminars and events

- All rooms are wheelchair accessible.
- Wi-Fi is available in all rooms free of charge.
- Amplification with a hearing loop system is available
- Flexible room layout to meet your needs

Catering and refreshments

The centre has an onsite café that can provide a wide range of catering to meet the requirement of the client.

Equipment available for use in all rooms (needs to be requested at time of booking) - including tables, chairs, flip-chart, data projection and amplification.

Our flexible meeting rooms can accommodate from two to 150 people for a multitude of events, including meetings, training workshops and conferences.

The chapel which seats over 500 people is also available for hire, restricted for Christian celebrations and meetings.

All rooms are competitively priced per session, **a session being a morning, afternoon or evening.**

Rooms for hire

Chapel

A large Grade II listed Victorian Chapel built in 1884. Pews as seating for 550 people.

Pipe organ, electric piano, projection and amplification facilities available.

Organist & other musicians available by arrangement at additional charge.

For Christian Celebrations and meetings only.

Chapel Lounge

A comfortable room suitable for up to 20 people.

Grosvenor Room

The Victorian church parlour, a room suitable for up to 20 people

Large Hall

This is a large Edwardian style hall, recently refurbished and licensed for entertainment purposes for a seating capacity of up to 150 people. The room contains a raised stage area and data projection facility. This room is ideally suitable for conferences, events and celebrations.

Small Hall

This hall is ideal for smaller conferences and events with a capacity for seating up to 70 people.

A well equipped kitchen facility is situated next to this room with a serving hatch connecting.

Main Kitchen

The kitchen adjacent to the small hall has extensive facilities including a hot water boiler, catering size cooker, commercial bain-marie, domestic cooker, microwave ovens, fridge, freezer and suitable catering equipment for up to 150 people.

The Suite

This a set of three rooms (Lounge, Regent Room, Westminster Room) with their own external entrance door. Kitchen and toilet facilities, including a young persons toilet, are also available.

3 rooms booked together £110 per session plus £10 for heating if required

The Lounge

This recently-refurbished room is an ideal meeting and training room suitable for 40 people. The room is equipped with lounge style seating and an adjacent kitchen with hot water boiler, domestic size hob and oven, hot plate and fridge .

£60 per session if booked alone + £10 for heating if required



Regent Room

This room is an ideal meeting and training room with a capacity for seating up to 50 people.



Westminster Room

This meeting room is suitable for up to 15 people and comes free of charge as a breakout room if booking other suite rooms



£30 per session if Booked alone plus £10 for heating if required

The Servery

This area is suitable for meetings, conferences and events.



£60 per session plus £10 for heating if required

The Meeting Place Cafe



Open daily for the public Monday—Saturday from 11.00—2.00

This facility also offers catering support for your conference or meeting.

- Data projection equipment — £10 per session
- Flip chart and pens — £5 per session
- Amplification available with loop system — £10 per room
- Wi-Fi available in all rooms (except the chapel) — free of charge



Direction to Queen's Road Baptist Church, Coventry

The church is on the edge of the City Centre, just off Junction 6 of Coventry Ring Road. [for satellite navigation purposes CV1 3FE](#)
Note however, that some maps and Sat Navs do not show recent changes to junction 6.

THE MAIN CAR PARK AND ENTRANCE TO THE CENTRE ARE ON GROSVENOR ROAD. PARKING IN OUR QUEEN'S ROAD CAR PARK IS LIMITED TO EVENINGS AND WEEKENDS ONLY

Free Parking is available in our Grosvenor Road Car Park

Whichever way you come into Coventry, follow signs towards the City Centre. Then:-

If you are approaching from the direction of Kenilworth/Warwick/Leamington: pass first the roundabout for the Central Six retail park, then turn sharp left immediately before the Ring Road bridge (red-painted road surface) and, keeping to the left, sweep into Grosvenor Road.

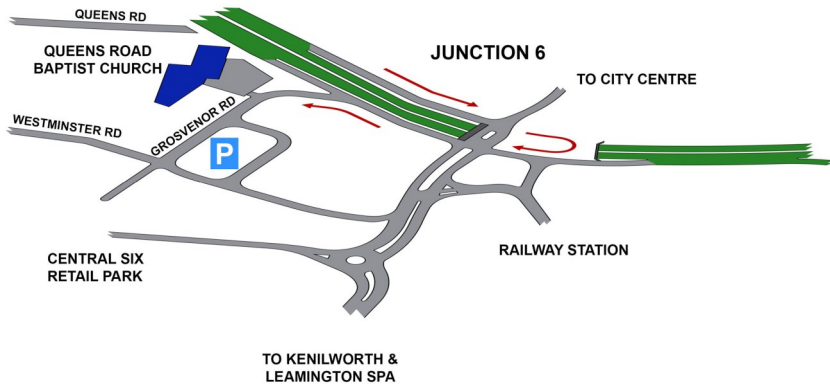
If travelling clockwise on the ring road: Leave the ring road at junction 6 and remain in the right-hand lane of the slip road. Do not turn left towards the railway station or Kenilworth, but at the Give-Way sign proceed straight on as though you were returning to the ring road. Immediately after crossing the junction move to the left-hand lane and sweep to the left into Grosvenor Road.

If travelling anti-clockwise on the ring road

You will see the church on the right as you approach Junction 6. Exit the Ring Road at that junction and stay in the right-hand lane of the slip road. At the Give-Way sign turn right towards Kenilworth and the Railway Station, but then **immediately** turn right again, as if you are going back onto the ring road in the direction from which you came. Move to the left-hand lane and sweep to the left into Grosvenor Road.

As you enter Grosvenor Road the church is on your **immediate** right. There is a car park at the church, and a 'pay & display' car park further down Grosvenor Road.
