Eco News from the Millennium Garden. As you're probably aware, we've been managing one quadrant of the area as a meadow. It's a bit of an experiment to see what will grow. Here are some of the plants currently flowering: Common Ragwort (bottom right); Yarrow (top right), growing from plug plants supplied by Tees Valley Wildlife Trust; a Yarrow seed head (bottom left) and white clover (centre).



Leaving this area to grow naturally as a meadow, helps insects and wildlife to flourish in this habitat. Many of these red soldier beetles (top left) were spotted on the Yarrow flower heads. Earlier in the year, solitary and bumble bees were spotted on the spring flowers. *Janet Hinton*
