When we are afraid for ourselves and our loved ones, give us your strength and courage.

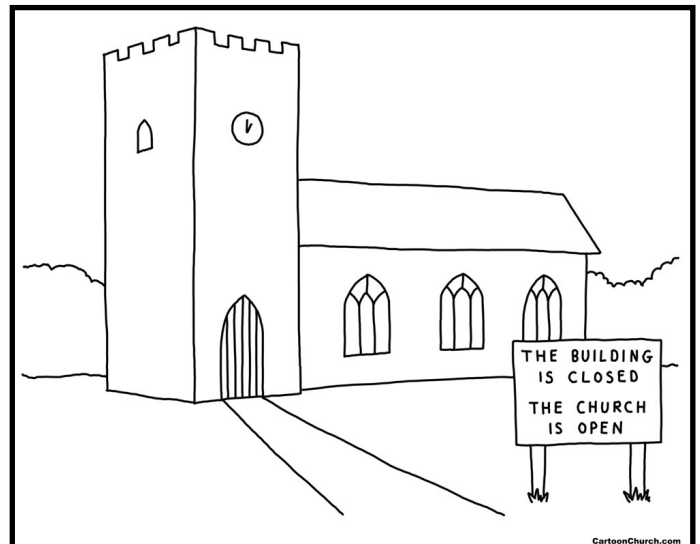
When we feel alone and isolated, reassure us with a sense of your presence.
