A Phishing Scam - Alert

Around the dioceses, people have become aware of an **online email scam** that has targeted **church officers** at local level. What happens is that an email which looks like one from the vicar (and is often very realistic) gets sent to people like churchwardens, treasurers and PCC members. The emails ask for a variety of things such as trying to get you to purchase vouchers or gift cards, but can also offer fake links to a deanery newsletter. Quite often, the emails come from this email address: churchonline948@gmail.com – but not always. They can look absolutely genuine, as the fraudsters behind the scam are doing their homework, probably by trawling national and local websites. **Please stay alert, be careful and know you have my assurance that I would never ask you to spend your own money for the church – and nor of course would Hannah or Peter. Finally, If you're not sure about an email, please always check with us and don't respond to the fake message.**

St Mary's Shrawardine - Autumn and Winter Opening Times

Since we were able to re-open our churches where it is possible, St Mary's has been open every day through the summer but things are changing as we move into the autumn.

Autumn - From 1st September: church open Saturday and Sunday only, approximately 10am - 5pm, for anyone who wishes to visit for private prayer.

Winter – From 25 October (when British Summer Time ends): open for Sunday services, any other services and at the request of anyone wanting to visit the church.
