

St Luke's Church Risk Assessment

Context: This risk assessment has been undertaken in preparation for opening the church to the public after closure due to Covid-19.

People entering/ leaving the Church	 Gathering of people at entrance Touching surfaces 	 Only one entrance is in use for congregation Vicar and servers use Sacristy entrance Congregation asked to sanitize hands before and after services 	Wheelchair/pushchair access will be maintained at all times
Congregation	 Social Distancing when seated Pews used twice on a Sunday Sharing the Peace Communion Collections taken during Mass 	 Seating areas are clearly marked and congregation are asked to only sit in marked bays which will be shown to them by whoever is greeting Pews are cleaned in between services There is no sharing of the Peace at the moment Communion is offered in only one form 	

		 Physical collections are not taken during Mass, congregation are encouraged to use contactless or to leave cash in collection baskets at the back of church. 	
Other rooms in building	 Meeting room Hall & Stage Area Kitchen Toilets 	 If the meeting room is to be used then it must be cleaned after use Hall to be used by Young Church during 1030 Mass (see YC risk assessment). If hall is to be used by congregation after/ as part of Mass then cleaning should take place of all furniture used and touch surfaces If the kitchen is use then it must be cleaned afterwards One toilet is available for use during Mass (disabled by hall) and should be cleaned using wipes by the user. 	Any areas touched must be disinfected at the end of each session Toilets must be disinfected All touch surfaces must be cleaned at the end of each session including door handles, windows, light switches, tables, chairs and other equipment used
