How do coniferous trees get ready for a date?

They spruce themselves up.

"Like a tree that's planted by the waterside, we shall not be moved." Some Christians are better at the latter part – nothing moves them!

Trees bear fruit – fruit that feeds other beings; fruit that ensures the reproduction of the species. The fruit doesn't benefit the tree itself. We are to bear fruit as Christians. The fruit of the Spirit grows in us for the benefit of others, that those we live with, those we come into contact with, will benefit from the love (and its segments of joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control). The test of whether or not the fruit is growing in me is in the benefits experienced by those around me. And, of course, that can lead to the fruit bearing, reproduction, of others coming to know Jesus for themselves.
