



**Olive branch** is a drop-in centre that can be found at the roundabout end of Castle Street. We run the Edgeley Foodbank on Wednesday mornings 10am – 12noon, and are currently open for drop-in on Mondays and Thursdays 2 – 4pm.

To make use of the **Foodbank**, customers need to obtain a pink voucher from one of our many local agents, for example Stockport Homes, Job Centre, CAB, Welfare Rights, your GP, etc.

For **drop-in** you can call into the centre for a bit of company or to make use of our free book exchange or you can find help with more practical things. The centre is equipped with computers, seating, a kettle and very friendly volunteers who can help you by:

- Providing a brew and a listening ear
- Helping you to fill out any forms that you are struggling with
- Helping you to sort out any 'on-line' stuff that is causing you a problem such as form filling or job applications
- Getting you started on computers

At Olive Branch you will always find a warm welcome and the kettle is always on!

Our project is also responsible for maintaining the planters down the length of Castle Street. We're always grateful for help with these.
