## Intro

If my grandmother really wanted me to listen, she'd say something that sounded like 'Sithirear'. That's not some foreign language but a blending of several separate words - 'See thee here'. We might say 'Look at me when I'm talking to you', or 'pay attention, this is important'.

You may have heard already that at St. Matthew's we're asking the church over the summer weeks to read through the *Gospel according to St. Luke* - or *Luke* for short! Not as an intellectual exercise; not because religious people read their Bibles; not because we want you to know more about Jesus (though we do!); but because reading the Bible is where we **get to know Jesus**, the one about whom this life is all about.

Can I suggest that over this next six weeks you find a quiet place, free of distractions (if that's possible); quiet yourself for a few moments (don't be in a hurry); pray that Jesus would meet you in your reading and that through God's Holy Spirit you might come to know him more?

If as you read an image grabs your attention, sit with it, mull it over, and hold it before God in your mind. Write in a journal or jot notes in the spaces below. Listen to an audio version or read it yourself. Tackle the book in one go; read it in large chunks; or in the 30 passages (5 a week) that we've prepared in this booklet.

Whichever way you read, it would be encouraging to us all if you share, through comments to our weekly Facebook posts, what is '*encouraging, challenging or stirring your heart*' as you make space to know Jesus more. **Sithirear - See thee here?**
