MESSAGE

Our Christmas readings in the book of Isaiah refer to a Light:

There will be a time in the future when Galilee of the Gentiles, which lies along the road that runs between the Jordan and the sea, will be filled with glory. The people who walk in darkness will see a great light. For those who live in a land of deep darkness, a light will shine. (9:1-2) ... For a child is born to us, a son is given to us. The government will rest on his shoulders. And he will be called, 'Wonderful Counsellor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace' (9:6-7)

In Genesis 1, God who is Light-Revealing-Truth, creates this world. Brokenness through doubt and disobedience brought darkness, but God promises, *people who walk in darkness will see a great light ... those who live in a land of deep darkness, a light will shine.* Light which creates **NEW** life! Life not terminated by death, but life which co-exists with God in eternity, beyond the bounds of time.

The pandemic brought on by the corona virus has wreaked havoc across all peoples of the earth. *'God with us'! You must be joking! Where was He when I lost my job this year? Where was He when I was home alone for nine months? Where was He when my father/mother/brother/sister died without any of us at his bedside? "Immanuel – God with us"? Take that Christmas card and put it straight in the bin.'*

Such thoughts and conversations represent our struggle, the reality of life as we live it on the one hand, and God's promise of life through His Son, Jesus our Christ on the other. Such struggles are a normal part of life.

What did Mary feel when the Angel said to her, *"The Son you will conceive and give birth to, and will name Jesus, will be very great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his ancestor David. He will reign over Israel forever; his Kingdom will never end!"* How can this possible when she had not yet moved in with Joseph!

How did Joseph feel when he discovered Mary was pregnant before they were living together, and God's Angel said, *"don't hesitate to get married to Mary. Her*

pregnancy is Spirit-conceived. God's Holy Spirit has made her pregnant. She will bring a son to birth, and when she does, you, Joseph, will name him Jesus—'God saves'—because He will save His people from their sins."

Then, when they had to flee to Egypt in the darkness of night, sure the thought crossed their minds, *'Where is God? Why is all this happening? The birth of a son, that to the promised Saviour of Israel, is to be a glorious time in our lives!'*

Matthew offers us a very practical, pastoral message about the presence of God in the darkest of times. He wants us to know, God has come to us in person to bring light into our darkness, and invites us to follow Him in obedience.

It is natural to have doubts, but the longer we linger in darkness, our doubts feed on anything but the Truth, because the darkness hides Truth from us.

But Truth has a way of emerging into Light for all to see. Truth can never be hidden and those who try to hide it, find themselves overcome by Truth. Hear the confessions and revelations of some for whom Truth set them free:

"I discovered that God was with me in the dingy darkness of a Clacton nightclub when I was way down the wrong path, and He lit up my mind with a question: 'Where is your life going?' "

"I found that God was with me in the lonely darkness of my bedroom as I wrestled again with how to make myself sick, and His presence shone a light of hope that life could be different."

"I met Jesus in my locked prison cell, serving time for my 98th conviction, and suddenly a new purpose began to shine in my life."

Jesus met thousands of people disappointed and discouraged by the human experience of life, those experiencing poverty, loss, temptation, betrayal and death. Yet, those whom others would avoid, He touched; those whom others turned away, he drew close; those whom others rejected, he ate with them.

The Bible, the only authoritative Word of God teaches us, *"Everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house*

on the rock. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against the house; yet it did not fall because it had its foundation on the rock.” (Matthew 7:24–27).

Jesus’ disciple John said, “Anyone who claims, “I am living in the light,” but hates a fellow believer, that person is still living in darkness. Anyone who loves a fellow believer is living in the light and does not cause others to stumble. But anyone who hates a fellow believer, is still living and walking in darkness. Such a person does not know the way to go, having been blinded by the darkness. (1 John 2:9-11)

John also revealed, “The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness can never extinguish it (What we believe about God which is not true, will be revealed; only Truth will survive and be known to all who seek it) John 1:5

The new year brings us face-to-face with the question:

Upon what will you build your life in 2021?

Will it be on the light that pierces the darkness, that the darkness cannot extinguish?

Jesus has given us the means (***Himself***), the method (***the Gospel***) and the strength (***The Holy Spirit***), to build our lives. Will we use these freely given?

Darkness may have dominated last year, but Christmas reminds us the greater truth: that Emmanuel has come into our darkness, illuminating our view of the world through the lens of Truth; then we can truly know and say, ‘*God is with us*’.

“I will take you by the hand and keep you; I will give you as a covenant for the people, a light for the nations” (42:6 later quoted in Acts 13:47)

I will make you as a light for the nations, that my salvation may reach to the end of the earth.” (49:6)

Grasp this promise of God and let Him make you the fulfilment of His promise.
