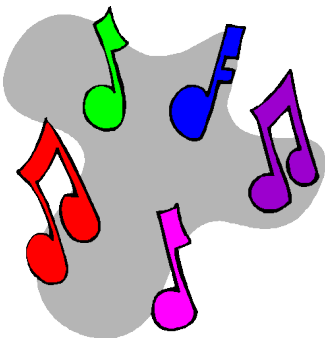
The Eucharist

people.

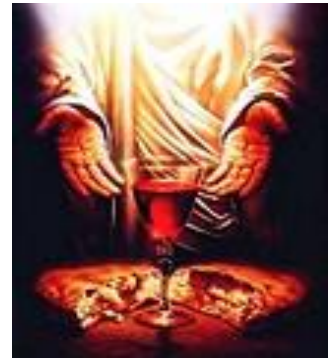
Jesus Christ is holy, Jesus

The minister distributes the communion in silence. Music is played. Those at home or not receiving communion are led by deacon in the Act of Spiritual Communion.
