Living in the Gap

In Luke's Gospel we hear the story, familiar to many of us, of Mary visiting her aunt Elizabeth, both of them pregnant in miraculous circumstances. It's the first meeting of John the Baptist and Jesus, even when they are both still in the womb. Elizabeth's baby leaps in her womb, and Elizabeth begins to prophesy in a loud voice, and twice in her

prophesy uses the word 'Lord' to describe the baby in Mary's womb.



Elizabeth is 'living in the gap' between carrying her child and giving birth to her son John; she's also living in the gap between the Old Covenant (Testament) and the New Covenant. Every Old Testament prophet proclaimed the coming birth of Jesus the Messiah, the Son of Man who would redeem Israel and draw all humanity back into a right

relationship with God. Advent is a time of 'living in the gap', waiting for the coming of our Lord in human form as well as looking forward to his Second Coming in glory.

Are you living in a gap at the moment? Why not ask the Holy Spirit to fill you as he did Elizabeth, and hear his truth for you at this Advent time.
