St Oswald's has registered to become an Eco Church and is working to obtain the Bronze Award.

Caring for God's creation at St Oswald's Church is supported by the framework supplied by Eco Church. Criteria are specified within this journey and the care pathway survey looks at several areas of Church life including:-

- *Worship and Teaching *Buildings and Energy
- *Land and Nature
- *Community and Global Engagement
- *Lifestyle

The Eco Church framework survey informs and supports us to take practical steps to enable positive choices to be made to eventually 'go green' in the care of God's creation. As we progress awards are given, bronze, silver and eventually gold.

Over a number of weeks a small group have been meeting taking a look at the questions posed in the survey, gaining lots of information and we are now in a position where we will hopefully be submitting our application to gain our bronze award very soon...... Let's All Keep Our Fingers Crossed!
