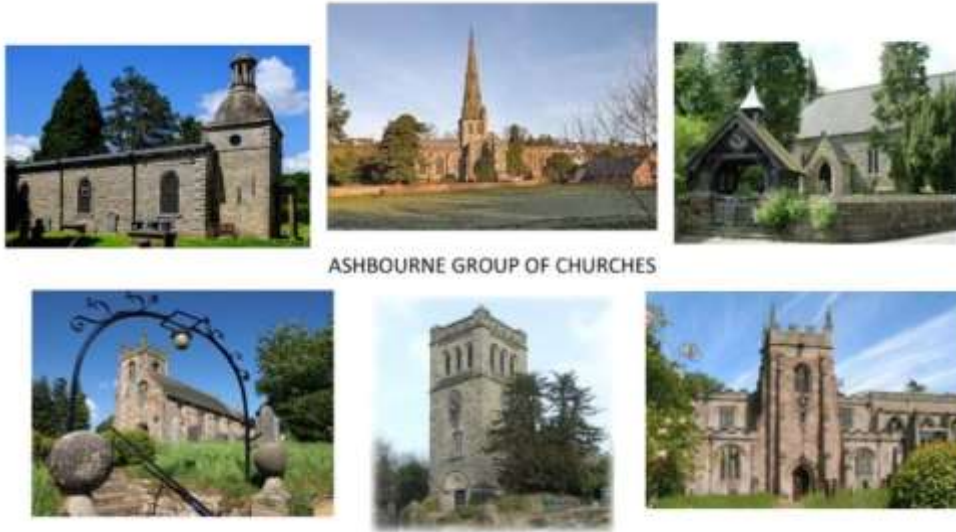

### We are trying something new at St John's!

We were looking for a way forward with our monthly congregation-led service and have found that Taizé style songs and prayers have slotted naturally into our services.

Rather than a full Taizé service it's more of a Taizé sandwich!

We start and finish with hymns, we have a bible reading or two then our prayers and intercessions are interspersed with Taizé songs usually accompanied gently by guitar.

Taizé-style worship\* offers an opportunity for peace and quiet, for stillness and reassurance. A simple style of sung prayer which welcomes and comforts you, whether you would say you are Christian, or not.

Come and sit a while with Bible readings, silence and singing. It is easy to learn Taizé chants as they are repeated again and again, using just a few words, which can penetrate our whole being, becoming a way of listening to God, to what is most important in our lives.

The service will normally be on a third Sunday of the month and with start at 9.30 (15 minutes later than our other services) and lasts up to 40 minutes.

A small gathering met in the library this morning to discuss last month's book 'Three Things about Elsie' by local author Joanna Cannon.

This book had been very much enjoyed, embracing insight into Dementia/Alzheimer's through the language and thought processes of Florence and Elsie. Florence, an 84 year old lady who had fallen in her flat at Cherry Tree Court, waits to be rescued whilst considering the charming new resident who looks exactly like a man she once knew – a man who died sixty years ago. His arrival had stirred up distant memories she and Elsie thought they had laid to rest.

The book this month is 'The Secret rooms' by Catherine Bailey – In April 1940 the 9th Duke of Rutland, one of Britain's richest men, ended his days in the servants' quarters of his home, Belvoir Castle. It was the end of months of manic. Secretive activity, and after his death his son ordered the rooms to be sealed.

For sixty years they remained untouched. What was he doing? And what secrets did the rooms hold?
