Changing Seasons

Ecclesiastes 3:1

As the season changes and we prepare for autumn, our All Age Service focuses on the seasons we experience in our lives - how we can prepare, how we manage them and what we can learn from them. Each of us experiences challenging times in our lives, and times of blessing too. We often refer to these as 'seasons'. We enjoy some and tremble at others. In the Bible, Saul, who became Paul, experienced dramatic seasonal changes in his life, especially when Jesus spoke directly to him and turned his life upside down. We will briefly explore some of the things Paul learned through his life and what we can learn from him.

PRAYER DIARY 11TH - 17TH SEPTEMBER

"In the same way that you gave me (Jesus) a mission in the world, I give them a mission in the world." From The Message John 17:18

Monday Please pray for Vietnam this week, increasingly becoming a popular tourist destination and yet local communities are often hostile to Christian converts demanding they denounce their faith and implementing practical hardships on them; and yet there are also Christian leadership and training initiatives and Christian groups reaching out to communities with practical love. Please pray for safety for believers and for God's work in Vietnam to be blessed.

Tuesday Many parts of India, such as Manipur, are suffering with churches being destroyed, violence against Christians and church leaders being persecuted by Hindu extremists who want them to return to Hinduism. The Indian government also shows a muted response to protecting Christians in India. Please pray for God to continue to reveal Himself to people in India and for safety for believers.

Wednesday Please pray for Christians in Egypt. Although the government is theoretically supportive of Christians, especially in many rural areas where Islamic groups hold influence, there is violence against Christians and discrimination in education and employment. Please pray for strength and hope and the love of God to surround believers.

Thursday Churches in the Middle East in Iraq and Syria have suffered so much due to war. Pray for the Christian local church leaders who continue to serve God in very difficult situations as they felt guided by God not to abandon their congregations and try to leave their country. Please pray that the message of Jesus will reach those who do not yet know the love of Jesus.

Friday Please pray for church leaders and churches meeting in secret in North Korea. Pray they will not be discovered. Pray for Christian material being smuggled into the country from China to reach its destinations without being detected. Pray that the church will grow through the power of the Holy Spirit!

Saturday Even in countries like Sri Lanka, Buddhist communities can oppose the construction of Christian churches, and Christian church leaders receive death threats. Please pray for this country.

Sunday Give thanks for our precious freedom of worship in the UK. Ask the Lord to reveal Himself to those who persecute His people around the world and lead them to the truth which will set them free.

All being well, we are seeking to run two Alpha courses this autumn ... but it relies on all of us to pray, get involved and invite people!

Alpha is a series of interactive sessions running over ten weeks that freely explores the basics of the Christian faith. It's for anyone who's curious. The talks are designed to encourage conversation and explore the basics of the Christian faith in a friendly, open and informal environment.
