Prayer Diary 15TH - 21ST July

Monday There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens. As we begin a season of change – as children prepare to change schools and as a new government begins office, we give thanks for the chance to reflect, to review and learn, and for new beginnings. Take time to listen to God's plans for you.

Tuesday a time to tear and a time to mend, a time to be silent and a time to speak, Give God thanks for the processes of democracy around the world. As we look back on our own process give thanks for peacefulness. As we look at other places such as France and the USA which have very different ways, pray for peace in the minds of decision makers, for integrity and wisdom to make a just way forward.

Wednesday a time to love and a time to hate, a time for war and a time for peace. At the time of writing, the NATO summit is taking place – pray for those nations in war situations. Lift to God the peoples of Ukraine and Russia, living under threat. Pray for the people of Israel and for the millions of displaced families living in fear and without basic needs in Gaza. We know that in our brokenness there is a time to kill and a time to heal, pray that healing will come swiftly in all such situations around the world.

Thursday no one can fathom what God has done from beginning to end. Ask God to help us remember that HE is in charge! Give thanks for the peace that God gives us in knowing we are loved. Wonder at the fact that He knows us and loves us and has chosen us from before time. Stay silent a moment to reflect, repent **and** rejoice that He is Alpha and Omega.

Friday I know that there is nothing better for people than to be happy and to do good while they live ... - this is the gift of God. We pray for those who are facing redundancy, for those who are in pay negotiations, for those, including new MPs, who have new roles and for those civil servants and others working under unfamiliar regimes. Pray, too for those who are seeking employment and fulfilment and for those who are looking to go on to training for the future.

Saturday a time to weep and a time to laugh, a time to mourn and a time to dance. The school holidays are upon us and we give thanks for the opportunity for families to be together, but pray too for those for whom it will be a huge struggle. We bring to our God of compassion those who can't escape the hardship brought on by lack of resources. We pray for the love of Christ to reach out from all church-based holiday clubs and food kitchens to communities in need, and we pray for Simon leading the VBC holiday club.

Sunday I know that everything God does will endure forever; nothing can be added to it and nothing taken from it. God does it so that people will fear Him. Praise God that He is eternally faithful and good. Praise God for His patience, forgiveness and compassion. Praise God for His Sovereignty. Praise God that we are able to bring our prayers to Him in humble adoration.
