Nate Morgan Locke is a filmmaker, preacher and "Reformed Mythologist" teaching on storytelling, theology and culture. For nearly two decades, he has developed evangelistic video and film series, including Christianity Explored, Life Explored, and, most recently, the 321 course for Speak Life, where he works as Creative Director. Nate literally grew up in Narnia (his parents' house, near Stokeon-Trent) and has seen the world as a fairy story ever since. He served at All Souls Langham Place and St Bart's Bath, before moving to Philadelphia to study at Westminster Theological Seminary. Nate now lives by the seaside in the UK with his wife and two children.



Nate will be speaking from the book of Obadiah:

"Essentially, God brings the proud down and raises the humble.

The people of Edom believe that God cannot "bring them down to the ground", but because of their treatment of their brother nation, Israel, the Lord will humble them.

As Christians we can be encouraged in our faith because, though we face opposition, Jesus is the humble one who comes down to save.

Prayer Diary 16TH - 22ND Sept

"Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Phillipians 4:6-7
