


CAROLS BY CANDLELIGHT -The Miracle of Christmas

PRAYER DIARY 1: 23RD - 29TH Dec

“For to us a child is born, to us a Son is given, and the government will be on His shoulders. And He will be called Wonderful Counsellor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. “. Isaiah 9:6

Monday Father, we lift up to You the people of Lebedyn who, this Christmas, are suffering terrible hardship as the war with Russia rages around them. We thank You for everyone involved with the Hope Lebedyn charity and with the money and supplies raised, which have helped Bohdan and his team deliver Your Good News practically to so many people throughout the year. We pray that our donation baskets will be well supported on Christmas Day so that Bohdan can deliver all his planned Christmas activities.

Christmas Eve Pray for the children and their families attending the Christingle service this afternoon. May they hear the message of the Christingle which symbolises the light of Christ bringing hope to the world’s people living in darkness.

Christmas Day “For to us a child is born, to us a Son is given“. Almighty Father, we thank You for giving us the most precious gift of all, Your son born in a stable, the Word made flesh in a little child. As we celebrate Christ’s birth this morning, pray that the light of His love will bring shining peace and brilliant joy to everyone who takes Him as their Saviour.

Thursday Loving Father, we pray that Your Holy Spirit will reach out to all those feeling lonely or finding Christmas a difficult time. Father, hold them in Your loving arms. Stir our hearts, Lord, to think of someone who would appreciate a call or a visit and encourage us to share with them God’s message of love and hope this Christmas.

Friday Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace, we lift up to You the situation in the Middle East, the place of Your birth which is at war with itself. We thank You, Lord, for giving the people of Syria the opportunity to live in peace. We pray for the military leaders of the HTS army to show humility, mercy and allow reconciliation to progress so that the country can be reunited in peace. Father, we ask for Your intervention in Gaza and Lebanon to persuade the politicians and their leaders to negotiate a peaceful settlement to end the destruction and heartache suffered by so many.

FUEL FOR PRAYER

Saturday Lord, we bring before You in prayer our church family members who are spending Christmas in hospital, struggling with poor health at home, and those waiting for test results and appointments. Let them know Your presence, Father, feel Your deep love for them, and know that their futures are safe in Your hands.

Bless them Father, and fill them with Your Holy Spirit so that even in the most difficult of times they can still experience the joy and wonder of the birth of the Christ Child.

Sunday Father, as we gather this morning we thank You for the freedom we have to worship together. We lift up to You those less fortunate who live in countries where they are persecuted for their faith and have to worship in secret.

Pray for the monthly evening services starting in January to be well attended and for the new format to encourage the younger generation to come and be spiritually enriched with the good news of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ.



TRIAL SUNDAY EVENING SERVICE

We will be having three trial, 6pm, Sunday Evening Services on the second Sunday of each month from January 2025 – 12th January, 9th February and 9th March.

The idea of having a Sunday evening service at VBC is not a new one: they have taken place in the past and the idea of starting them again has been talked about for the last few years. The issue of actually starting one has come down to, 'Is this God's timing?' These thoughts have also been influenced by the Church Holy Spirit Day on 6th April 2024 and the desire to create an environment where there is more opportunity to allow the Holy Spirit to work freely.

The style of the service has been influenced by a group in their twenties and we hope to see young adults enjoying the evening service followed by hotdogs and drinks. The service is open to all ages.



PRAYER DIARY 3: 6TH - 12TH Jan

He has made everything beautiful in its time. He has also set eternity in the human heart; yet no one can fathom what God has done from beginning to end. Eccles 3:11 - As we enter a new year it is a good time to reflect on our blessing from last year and pray for God to continue to grow His Kingdom in 2025

Monday: Look back to 2024 and Thank God for the blessings in your life, the way God has provided. Whatever your circumstance, God has been active. Seek out the blessings and thank Him. Thank God too for the blessings we have had at VBC. Church growth, conversions, baptisms. Spend time praising God for His many blessings to our community of VBC.

Tuesday: As schools return after the holiday please pray for our school teachers in the local schools. Pray that our Christian brothers and sisters working in schools are able to shine the light of Christ to children and colleagues. Pray too for the children. Some find school a fearful place full of anxiety and stress. For others it is a lonely place as friends are thin on the ground. Finally for some it is a place of refuge, a safe place where the problems at home can be forgotten for a short time. Pray that Christ will shine on them and reveal His love to them all.

Wednesday: Our Church is a busy place. Today pray for the ministries that go on here. For example Community Fridge, CAP, the Brigades, youth and children's work, Women's and Men's Fellowship. the prayer meetings, Life Groups, Omega, Alpha ... and much more. Pray that God uses these to draw people to Him through the work of these ministries. Pray too for those who rent the building regularly: Bub Club, Karate Club, Rock Choir, Lindy Hop, U3A, NHS Blood Doning service, and Sussex Wildlife Trust. Pray that God will speak to people through the building itself and the welcome people receive.

Thursday: Thursday is our Ukraine focus. As I write this in December, the war still rages in and around Lebedyn. Pastor Bohdan and the team continue to work to serve the people of Lebedyn through food distribution, children's work, church services, puppet shows, pastoral visiting, blanket and sheet making, computer classes, and so much more. Please pray for God's protection over the team and the buildings. God's Kingdom is growing in Lebedyn, lives are being changed amid the struggles of war. Pray for energy, strength, uplifted spirits and hope. Pray too that the young men such as Farmer Sergey and Valentin can escape conscription into the army.

FUEL FOR PRAYER

Friday: With the uncertainty in Syria at present, please pray for Christians who are still there. Pray that any new regime will allow them to worship freely. Pray also for all our brothers and sisters in Christ who live under persecution in places such as Gaza, Israel, North Korea, Somalia, Afghanistan, Iran and Pakistan. Pray for the church leaders to have God's wisdom and the Holy Spirit's strength to lead their churches. Pray for those in prison to have hope and be reminded of scripture as they are isolated from friends and family. Pray that those who persecute will see the light of Christ and turn to Him.

Saturday: Scripture teaches us to pray for our government and those in authority over us. Whatever your political colour, pray for our Prime Minister. He professes to be an atheist. Pray that Christians in Parliament will have influence over him. Pray for Godly wisdom for our government, to unite the nation, to have compassion in their decision making and put people before money. Pray too for the King and the royal family, that the late Queen's faith would continue to influence them. Pray for their spiritual advisers. Finally pray for the Anglican church in its journey to find a new Archbishop. May they choose a truly Godly person to unite them.

Sunday: Today, pray for God's word to be revealed to us. Thank God for Christ's leadership and his faithfulness to scripture. Pray too for our leadership team, the CLT. May they be inspired to lead us well and direct the church in the way God wants it to go. Pray for wisdom for all the staff team who work in the offices each day. Chris, Colin, Kevin, Sandra, Julie, Tim, Lucy, Simon, Jez, Phil and Nadine. Thank God for the blessing they have been in helping VBC become the church that it is. But also pray for vision for 2025, that they may be faithful to God's lead and call.
