If you are interested and willing to help, then you can do so in two ways:



1. Collect a shoebox (max. size 33 x 20 x 15 centimetres 13 x 8 x 6 inches) with a separate lid (not hinged) and fill it with suitable gifts for boys and girls of different ages

(1-3 years; 4-7 years; 8-11 years; 12-15 years)
For example: cuddly toys, toothbrush and paste, soap and face cloth, combs, notepad, colouring and picture books, pencils, crayons and pens,

hats, gloves and scarves, small balls, toy cars, jigsaw puzzles.

NO: sweets, food, liquids, medicines of any kind, battery powered items, war related items (e.g. guns, knives, etc.), books of a religious, racial or political nature, large items of clothing, shoes or toys, any sharp items.
