NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

Improve the church's internet connectivity and audiovisual capability, to enable services and community events to be streamed and audiovisual material to be incorporated in services and community events.

Proposed works:

Upgrading broadband and wifi connectivity (partially completed);

Upgrading existing sound system, including replacing existing seven loudspeakers with three of higher specification;

Installing a remote-controlled drop-down projection screen, attached to and hidden behind the 20th century rood beam, ensuring that the casing as far as possible matches the colour of the beam so as to be inconspicuous when closed;

Installing a high-powered keystone-corrected projector, on the west wall to the south side of the west window, mounted on an architect-designed bracket;

Installing a remotely controlled Pan/Tilt/Zoom (PTZ) camera on a column on the north side of the nave;

Installing a small fixed-lens camera above the PTZ camera;

Installing a lockable control desk in a rear pew in the north aisle;

Installing necessary wiring and raising nave lights to support the above modifications.
