We have an opportunity to work more with our local community, as we are now members of the Ealing Citizens organization (part of the West London Citizens) whose aim is to give communities the power to change issues that matter to them.

But we need your help.

On the national agenda they have tackled issues such as better mental health access, housing and homelessness and rehousing refugees, more local campaigns in Ealing include concerns about housing and the costs of buying and renting and environmental issues.

We would be looking to start on a smaller scale on an issue that matters to us within our community. We have a small group already, but for it to be a success we need a core team of about 8 members.

Our aim is to build up a team over November and December, then after Christmas run a 'listening campaign' to find out what is important to us in our local community and identify where we would like to see change.

We then choose a campaign to work on and run it in the Spring.

If it all sounds a bit over-whelming don't worry - we're new to this as well.

Ealing Citizen's will help all the way, providing training and advice.

There is a training day on the 18th November, which you are invited to join and there will be other training opportunities in the future.

We're really excited about this opportunity and convinced it can make a real difference.
