What we are looking for: A spirit filled, self-motivated individual with a passion for God and people, skills in administration, team building and communication. A degree or other qualification in theology is desirable and a solid knowledge of the Bible is essential – together with the ability to work effectively with the leadership team, staff and volunteers. We are happy to flex the role for the right person but envisage the role focussing on pastoral care, spiritual formation and discipleship, responsibility for small groups and the wider leaders and teaching at our gathered church services.
