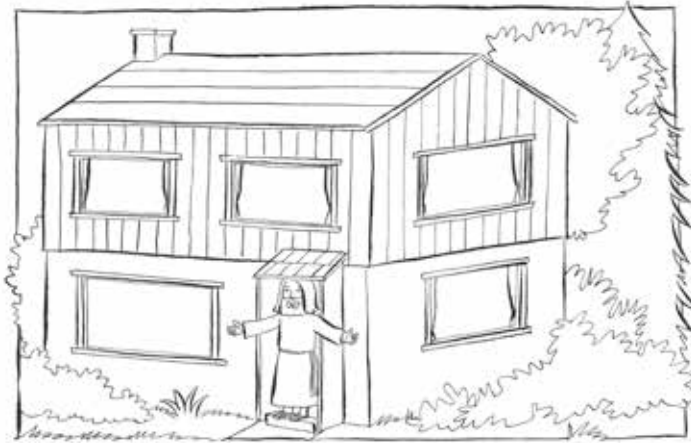
## Ephesians 2.14, 21-22
