Essential information for attending church in person

Please read all of this leaflet before attending church.

In order to help us know how best to arrange seats for the morning services, please fill in the form https://forms.gle/tAKEs7BM2m4d9WV28 and wait for confirmation that there is a place for you to attend. We can accommodate up to 40 people in 12 areas/slots.

The service will still be streamed online, even if you can't be present in church.

We are conforming to Welsh Regulations in order to protect one another. Please ask for our Health and Safety Risk Assessment if you would like see it.

You MUST NOT ATTEND if you have had COVID SYMPTOMS or been in contact with someone with symptoms in the last 14 days. You must also follow government guidance for self-isolation if you have attended certain foreign countries.

Please let us know so we can allocate your seats to others.

- 1. **Singing** is not permitted.
- 2. The collective administration of the **Lord's supper** is not permitted. We invite people to bring their own elements when we hold this service. Usually the first Sunday of the month.
- 3. People are required to adhere to the **2m social distancing** when entering/moving around. Please ensure that you and your family can keep to the 2m social distance rules.
- 4. You will be asked to confirm that during the last 14 days you have not had Covid-19 **symptoms**, or been in contact with anyone who has.
- 5. There will be **signs** reminding to social distance, and maintain hand-hygiene. There will also be a one-way system, and most doors will be wedged open to reduce the surfaces touched. Please follow the marked route.
- 6. **Hand-gel** will be available when entering and exiting, and you are welcome to wear a mask if you would like to but it is not a requirement.
- 7. Please bring your **own Bible**. The church ones are not available at the moment.

- 8. No **offering** will be taken. Those who would like to give in this way will be able to do so via a box available in the foyer.
- 9. There is **no provision for Sunday school**, creche or toys, due to social distancing measures. Your child must be able to maintain social distancing.
- 10. **Toilet facilities** are available. Hand dryers are permitted or the use of paper towels.
- 11. **Children** under the age of 11 must not use the toilets unattended.
- 12. If you use the toilet, please **spray** the seat after use with the sanitiser provided, as well as following hand-washing hygiene.

If paper towels or spray is not available, please inform a steward.

- 13. We are **not permitted to gather** together before or after the service.
- 14. **No refreshments** are permitted to be served at the moment.
- 15. Please let us know immediately, at any time after your visit, if **Covid19 symptoms** develop so we can take necessary steps to let others you were in contact with know.
