BIBLE READING 1 SAMUEL 1

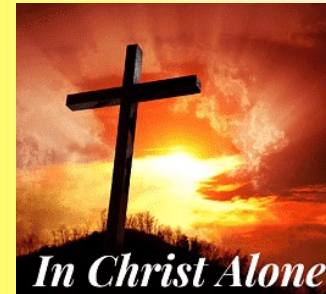
