LORD, I love the house where you live, the place where your glory dwells.

Psalm 26 v8

#### 8.00am and 9.30am Readings

Hebrews 1: 1 - 4, 2: 5 - 12 - in his letter, Paul tells the Hebrews that God, who once spoke to their ancestors through angels, now speaks to us all through his Son. Jesus promised that he would "...proclaim your name to my brothers and sisters, in the midst of the congregation I will praise you." (v12)  
Mark 10: 2 -16 - When the disciples spoke sternly to the children gathered about him, Jesus said to them - "Let the children come to me, do not stop them; for it is to such as these that the kingdom of God belongs," (v14)
