Deanery Consultation - We would like to update you on the Consultation Process. Following the report going to the Bishops. At the beginning of this week the Archdeacon and Area Dean visited each church and it's representatives for this process and reported to them that the Bishops have agreed with the report and it's recommendation that Option 2 would be best for the 5 churches involved. St Paul's, Kewstoke, will join with St Lawrence, Wick St Lawrence, St Peter's will have missionary outreach for Mead Vale Area. St Mark's will be stand alone, as will St Martin's. Now that Option 2 has been agreed, details of how this will proceed will follow shortly.

We would like to thank all those involved this far and for everyone's prayers. Please continue to pray, that the workings out of disbanding the parish go well for everyone involved and that God would be glorified through this process. Rev Chris Elms, Rev Emma Amyes, Rev Gilly Bunce and Paul Elliott.
