In the parish there are 2 vacancies for Church Wardens. 9 vacancies for PCC (3 x 3 years, 3 x 2 years and 3 x 1 year) and 2 vacancies for Deanery Synod Representatives. Being on the PCC also means enabling you to bring your prayers and suggestions to contribute to the balanced running of our church. This is vital if we want to see growth and change at St Martin's.
