*Yet you have made them a little lower than the heavenly beings

Psalm 8: 4-6

The Psalms tell us of the dignity and purpose of humanity in the intentions of God. We are meant to reflect the glory of God in our relationships and in our work. Slavery denies both of these, by removing the agency of the individual and the fruitfulness of their labour. On this day we pray for an end to Modern Day Slavery.

Holy God,

we repent of the part we have played in allowing this dreadful crime to become established in our communities. We are sorry for our apathy, indifference and busyness. We join our cries for help to all the hidden voices of your children suffering from criminal exploitation. As we learn to recognise and share their pain, may we be brought closer to all around us who are hurting in this way, so that together we may be ready to know your healing love.

We raise our prayers to you for the increasing number of victims of slavery and trafficking. Whisper hope into their ears and wipe away their tears. Help us see them and support them. Inspire our church communities to tackle the root causes of modern slavery so that hurt may be healed, despair becomes hope, and isolation become fellowship – through our suffering saviour, Jesus Christ,
