Replacement of the timber framed fire escape doors of the link corridor between the church and church hall with a new set of fire escape doors with double glazing and aluminium frame and surround.

Replacement of the external timber door and surround at the rear of the church hall, facing north. The replacement door and surround to be aluminium framed and double glazed.

The aluminium framing for both the sets of replacement doors and surrounds to be coloured green RAL6005.

A letter of objection must include your name and address and state whether you live in the parish and/or your name is entered on the church electoral roll of the parish or any other basis on which you have an interest in the matter.

Directions to petitioner

You must display this public notice (or a copy of it) for a continuous period of not less than 28 days, not counting the day on which it was put up or the day on which it is taken down, (or for such other period as the Court may direct and subject to any special directions of the registrar) in each of the following places:

1. on a notice board or in some other prominent position inside the church; and
2. on a notice board outside the church or in some other prominent position (whether on the outside of the church door or elsewhere) so that it can be read by the public.
