

The discipleship growth programme is helping me to develop a deeper understanding of the word. It is helping me to understand who God is and

what He's expecting of how I should conduct myself.

Through the teaching of the Bible I've learnt that being obedient is an important gift as through obedience to God, we can do all things. Through obedience we recognise that we are mere people with the need to allow God to direct our lives. Obedience allows us to let God be God. It's through allowing God to lead us that we can become selfless and not get comfortable in seeing others suffering. Through discipleship we learn to give back what we've been given.

I've been painting since a very young age and have always had a passion for helping others. This passion in giving came from seeing my mother paying her tithes. My mum told me at the age of 3, when we came to Church and they were collecting tithes, the only money she had was to buy milk for us. However, she gave all the money she had in tithing. I didn't understand what tithe meant at the time, so she told me she gave it to God. I was confused why my mother would do such a thing. But the next day, she was blessed immensely financially.

There's only one income in my household but we are fine. Some of my friends with two parents seems to struggle financially. I've asked my mother how so? Her response is because she's obedient and gives back to God what He's blessed us with.

I've decided that it's important that I give back to others what God has blessed me with. So, I decided on giving my paintings to charity by selling my paintings and donating the money to the homeless. My charity is called 'Hope for the Homeless'. I try to incorporate the word of God on most of my paintings, not just as a word of encouragement to others but so that others will realise that God is love and when we follow Him, love will be a part of us.

There are a lot of positive feed backs for the paintings that I do. Paintings can be quite time consuming and some pieces can take from a few hours to days. My painting and Charity make me feel like I am doing this for a good cause and not only that, I feel that my passion and hobby are appreciated. It's a gift that I've been given and I'm simply giving back what God has given me so I can help others. I would encourage young people like myself just to explore and focus on what you have a passion for. See how far you can go and try to help others with what you are doing. Never give up, and always remember that whatever you do, God is watching and will be proud of you if you use your giftings in the right way.

Whilst I love the discipleship programme, I wouldn't be able to fully comprehend it without the help of my mother. So, I suggest that it could be made more simple and youth friendly.


