



This is my Testimony

Ernieford Orlando Barrett



I was born in Jamaica in a small town called Lionel on the plains of Vere in the parish of Clarendon. I am the eldest of three children (second

of 4 for my father). I migrated to England and settled in Northampton in August 2011.

I was raised in a Christian home. My parents were Anglicans and were very involved in the local church - my father was a lay leader. ı started attending confirmation class and got baptised when I was ten years old and became quite involved in the church. I was an Altar Boy, youth leader, a member of the men's group and eventually sang bass on the choir. I lost my faith a few times along the way as well as moving from one denomination to another. In due course, I was moved by a sermon whilst attending a Sunday service and rededicated my life to Christ. That was the beginning of my Christian journey.

When I came to Northampton in 2011, I started accompanying my wife to College Street NTCG and

have worshipped here ever since. I have an interest and skills in PA systems and during this time served or assisted the church mainly in this area before I became a member in 2020.

As a member of the PA and Praise and Worship teams, I'm now involved in two areas of ministry at College Street NTCG. The PA provides me with an opportunity to use and develop my skills as well as give thanks and praise to God and bless my brothers and sisters by providing the best I can with sound. Singing on the Praise and Worship team allows me to connect even closer to the Lord and the delightful privilege to use something I enjoy doing, especially when I do it well, to worship God and bless others in the process.

What I like most about College St. NTCG is that I identify with the membership, even though I come from an Anglican background. I especially enjoy the fellowship with the men in the church.

I am a husband and a father amongst other roles in life. My wife Yvett and I have five sons who are all grown up now. I consider parenthood to be a real privilege as I believe God lends us the gift of children for us to mentor and provide guidance to them so that they will do the same for their children. I believe it is very important that we as parents pass on the best values we can to them.

Life is full of challenges and opportunities or to put this another way: shocking and pleasant surprises.

When I turned 50 years old, one challenge for me was that I realised my mortality in a greater way. It just seems like I don't have much time anymore. Then there are times when it seems harder to maintain my self-esteem as I don't always feel that I get things right. I challenge face the also loneliness. Yes, I have lovely work colleagues as well as church brothers and sisters. sometimes I feel that there is no one to confide in. This loneliness feels greater when I'm in the UK. Thankfully I am able to draw on some specific scriptures that help me deal with these challenges, for example:

"So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand" Isaiah 41:10

"God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble" Psalm 46:1

"When my father and my mother forsake me, then the Lord will take care of me" Psalm 27:10.

I thank God for my growth in faith and discipleship. I benefit from my interactions in church with members of the Praise and Worship Team, the Men's Ministry, speaking to the Pastors as well as the membership. It's especially important for me to interact with the men (especially the elders) of the church as I benefit from their wisdom

I pray that each member of our church will continue to grow in faith and in the love of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. May our prayers, times of fasting and time in the word strengthen us. May we be empowered in our commitment to the promises found in Proverbs 3:5-6 'Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. I n all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.'

IMPORTANT CHURCH GUIDANCE

As the Covid-19 restrictions have been relaxed over the last few months we have welcomed more members and visitors attending church services. However, in recent weeks the rates of Covid cases in Northampton have been fluctuating.

As a precaution for the health and safety of everyone I have made the decision that face coverings are worn and social distancing reinstated in College Street.

I am encouraging everyone to remain cautious and observe to the following:

- All attendees will have their temperature checked on arrival. If you have a temperature of 37.8 degrees Celsius or above, you and your travelling companions will be asked to return home, self-isolate and seek medical attention.
- Hand sanitizer stations will remain at the entrance and exit of the building, please use these as often as you can.
- All attendees are encouraged to wear a face covering/ mask in the main sanctuary.
- If you choose not to wear a face covering/mask, please continue to maintain social distance with others.
- Follow the Steward's instructions as they direct you to your seat.

- It is essential that if you have Covid symptoms, however mild, or test positive for Covid, please inform a member of the Leadership team, and follow the Government guidelines. Most importantly, please do not attend church to ensure the safety of others.
- If you feel anxious, please speak to Colleen Coates of the Pastoral Care team. Be assured we will take care of you and the safety of all our members and friends.
- Any further changes will be reviewed as guided by data from Government and Public Health. We will ensure that you are informed before any formal decisions are made.

We continue to focus on ensuring that **everyone** that comes into our church can worship in a safe environment and we will continue to do so by God's grace.
