Malvern Foodbank

Thank you for your continued support of the foodbank. The foodbank remains busy and since the start of April we have already fulfilled 101 vouchers providing 261 food parcels (this includes 103 children) to those in need in the Malvern Hills area.

The supermarket collection points at Waitrose, Morrisons, Lidl Malvern Link, Co-op Malvern Link, Co-op Upton, Sainsbury's Malvern Vale and Just So Barnards Green are regularly emptied and any donations of food can be left in one of these. Donations can also be left at the warehouse in Spring Lane (Monday and Thursday 10.15 -12.30 and Tuesday 1-3) or the Lyttelton Well (Monday – Friday 10-4).

Psalm 96

Cantate Domino

1. O SING unto the Lord a new song: sing unto the Lord, all the whole earth.
2. Sing unto the Lord, and praise his Name: be telling of his salvation from day to day.
3. Declare his honour unto the heathen: and his wonders unto all people.
4. For the Lord is great, and cannot worthily be praised: he is more to be feared than all gods.
5. As for all the gods of the heathen, they are but idols: but it is the Lord that made the heavens.
6. Glory and worship are before him: power and honour are in his sanctuary.
7. Ascribe unto the Lord, O ye kindreds of the people: ascribe unto the Lord worship and power.
8. Ascribe unto the Lord the honour due unto his Name: bring presents, and come into his courts.
