This is a series of "That's not my ..." books. The book identifies what is special about each creature, using various textures to help tell the story. Any of these books would be great to share with your little one(s).

The whole of Psalm 139 is a reminder of how well God knows us. The Bible tells us that God even knows how many hairs there are on our heads.

God knows children of every size – really small to really big! God knows children of every nation and every colour! God knew all children before they were even born! The Bible says “God knows us better than we know ourselves”. Wow!

This month you could:

- Try counting the hairs on someone's head.
- Use the book to explore the different textures, then explore different textures in your home.
- Take time to look at your child, in this moment, to just appreciate them for who they are with their wiggly toes and funny ways.
- Look at the members of your family and draw pictures of each other, showing your different features.
- Play an observation game like snap or the tray game use the internet to get some more ideas.
