

# Your Baptism Journey

*'The kingdom of Heaven is like a mustard seed' Matthew 13:31-32*



'The Tiny Seed' by Eric Carle. An enchanting story of the journey of a seed, as the seasons pass. In Autumn, the tiniest seed gets blown by the wind and it travels far and wide, we travel with the through the seasons. What will happen to the tiny seed?

Jesus describes Heaven like a mustard seed. The Tiny seed becomes the tallest of plant, so tall that people come to see it. In Palestine where Jesus was from a very familiar sight would have been mustard bushes that grow six to twelve feet high, which flocks of birds would rest in as they enjoyed snacking on the tiny black mustard seeds. The huge bushes grow from tiny black seeds which measure 1-2 mm.

A seed is the beginning, it looks like nothing important or special, but seeds can grow into beautiful plants, that themselves make seeds so more plants can be sown. Many Christians worry their faith in God is not big enough, but God wants us to nurture our faith so that it will grow into something beautiful and inspiring, so inspiring that we plant the seed of faith in others.

## Things for you to try this month:

- Plant a seed, nurture it and watch it grow, save its seeds to plant more.
