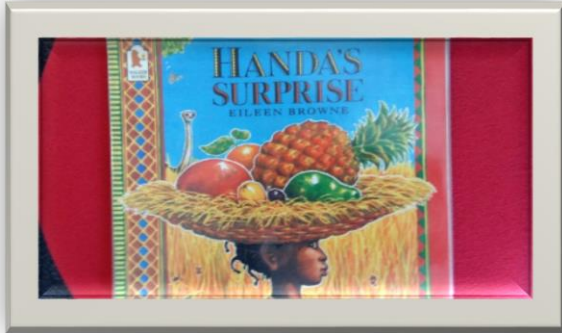


Your Baptism Journey
